Now it's easy to go kosher and we look forward to making it even easier!

If you've attended a Kashrut course, either at Chabad House or your shul and are ready to g

Kasher your Kitchen, we will gladly help you in the following ways:

- Chabad House koshering team will be available by appointment to kasher kitchens of those who are Going Kosher for the first time as part of the Go Kosher initiative.
- If you are unable to afford the costs of going kosher, Chabad House will partner with you to share some of the initial start-up costs, including:
  - 1 Sponsoring the koshering team and their time and charges – value – R1000.
  - 2 Sponsoring 50% of the kiln charges to kasher crockery – up to R700 per home.  
(Average kiln charge is between R700 and R1000 per home)
  - 3 Chabad House will give you a start-up hamper consisting of two frying-pans, two baking trays, a basic braai or grid, a cutting board and a set of basic crockery – just to help you get started.
- Everyone who kashers their home through Chabad House during the Go Kosher campaign will receive a set of 12 R100 vouchers from Moishes Butchery to be used over the first year of your Going Kosher experience.
- These will be a one-off gift to thank you for Going Kosher. They are not transferable and must be used before their stated expiry date, after which they are null and void.
